This year's fundraiser will benefit the Broward Center's arts-in-education programs which use the arts as learning tools to help children achieve in school.

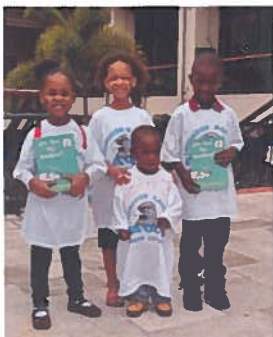

- ◆ \$10,000 provides 625 students who participate in the Broward Center's *Reading Readiness* Program with 4-5 home library and holiday books. *Reading Readiness* is a multi-disciplinary program that prepares at-risk, four-year-old Head Start children to enter kindergarten ready to read by integrating live theater performances with classroom activities and parent workshops.



- ◆ \$5,000 underwrites a *Smart Stage Matinee* Show for 590 students. The *Smart Stage Matinees* are literature-based shows that reinforce reading, science and math skills with productions that challenge students to learn.



- ◆ \$2,000 pays for two teaching artists at \$100 per day for 10 days to develop the Broward Center's *Play Scenes*, an innovative, new program that uses nursery rhymes, repetitive learning and original musical productions to develop early childhood learning skills.
- ◆ \$1,500 underwrites one *Smart Stage Matinee* Show for a class of 60 students with bus transportation to and from the theater and a *Smart Stage Plus* post-show activity.
